# Key Stage 4 Curriculum

- Prepare them for life after Year 12/Post-16

# Key Stage 4 Curriculum Structure

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Three core strands to the curriculum:

#### Core Subjects

- Maths
- English
- Science

# Statutory Subjects (not assessed)

- Physical Education
- Religious Education
- LLW

#### Optional Subjects

- Personal choice based on personal strengths and chosen career pathway
- 4 subjects

- GCSE courses and GCSE equivalent courses
- Controlled Assessment, Portfolio and Examinations

# Options Process - 3 Stages

#### Stage 1

- Expression of Interest1
- One list of subjects
- Done in current bands

#### Stage 2

- Expression of Interest2
- One list of subjects
- Done in Pathways

#### Stage 3

- Final optional subject choices made
- 4 separate option blocks
- Done in Pathways

# Stage 1 - Expression of Interest 1

#### **Options Afternoon**

- > Talk to **specialist teachers** about the range of subjects on offer.
- Use the time to ask important questions.
- Tonight, look at the booklet again when everything is fresh in you mind.

#### **After Options Afternoon**

- First Expression of Interest form to be completed.
- Students should indicate the four subjects that they think they would like to study and should do this in order of preference with 1 being the subject they wish to study the most.
- Students will receive further guidance in LLW lessons and should speak to specialist teachers in school if they need to.
- Form returned by Friday 11<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

#### Stage 1 - Expression of Interest for Key Stage 4 Subjects - L and H Band

Chaose the top four subjects which you would prefer to study at KS4, and number them 1 – 4 in order of preference. Please note that this subject survey is only to gather information on the popularity of the subjects on offer. This is <u>NOT</u> your final chaice of subjects for Year 11 and 12.

During the process of selecting these options, you should:

- 1. Refer to the Curriculum Booklet given to you during the Options Afternoon.
- Speak to your subject teacher about the course if it is a subject you already study.
- 3. If you have a question about any of the subjects or how you should chaose your subjects, ask your LLW teacher during LLW lessons.

## **Pathways**



#### Pathway 1

Includes a range of **both academic** and vocational qualifications.

Suited to pupils whose preferred learning style suits assessment through examination and coursework.

Facilitates progression onto Sixth Form and University and well as FE and Employment.





#### Pathway 2

An alternative pathway suited to students who perform better through the applied curriculum and project based work.

Pupils must study GCSE English, GCSE Mathematics and Science.

Facilitates progression on to Further Education and Employment.

# Stage 2 - Expression of Interest 2

- A second Expression of Interest form will be given to students after Christmas.
- At this point, the students will be able to **choose between Pathway 1 and 2** (Baseline data and internal assessment used to inform this as well as conversations with parents).
- Again, students will indicate the four subjects they believe they would like to study, again, ranking them 1-4.
- Please note that students do not need to choose the same 4 subjects that they chose at stage 1. Preferences may change as they move further into year 10 and learn more about their subjects.
- **Options booklets** should be referred to again during this process.

# Purpose of Stages 1 & 2

- Thinking throughout year 10 about options choices.
- Inform the Staffing and Timetabling structure within the College.
- Curriculum offer is decided based on student feedback in these two stages.
- Option blocks for students to make their final option choices are designed based this feedback with the aim of allowing them to access as many of their choices as possible.

# Stage 3 - Final Options Choices

This is where students submit their final choice for their four optional subjects.

> Option booklets should be referred to again during this process.

> This stage will be carried out in March 2023.

## Option Blocks

Students will choice their options subjects within the pathway that is most suitable for them.

- > Subjects are offered in **four blocks**.
- The option blocks will be created based on your feedback in Stages 1 and 2

> The options blocks will offer a breadth of choice and will allow for various career and education pathways.

## **Option Blocks**

- Pathways and option blocks have been designed to support pupil achievement.
- > Subjects may not run if deemed unviable due to low uptake.

## How to use Option Blocks

Students must choose a first and second choice in each of the four blocks.

Do not choose the same subject as your first choice in 2 or more blocks.

In some cases, students may not be awarded their first choice and will be placed in their second. Therefore, it is important that students carefully consider their second choice.

# **Choosing Subjects**

#### Don't choose subjects based on:

- What your friend is choosing.
- Liking/not liking the teacher.
- Because a sibling studied the subject in the past.
- > Finding it easy in years 8-10.
- > Thinking it is a "bit of a laugh".



# **Choosing Subjects**

#### Do choose subjects because:

- You are good at the subject (as your tracking grades show).
- > You **enjoy** the subject.
- The subject matches your skills and qualities.
- > You are considering a career in a related area.
- You have considered current labour market trends STEM based subjects, for example.
- You like the method(s) of assessment used.
- > You are most likely to achieve 5+A\*-C



# Supporting Your Child

- Role of Careers advice at this stage is essential.
- Pupils should listen to the advice of the school:
  - Specialist teachers
  - > LLW lessons
  - Options booklet
- Attendance is essential for success.
- Take time to talk at home about career paths, job opportunities and the strengths of your children as well as looking at the Options booklet together.
